

Club History

LOCATED IN BEAUTIFUL CASTLE ROCK, the dramatic elevation changes provide spectacular views of the nearby mountains. The Plum Creek Golf Club layout features railroad ties surrounding the greens, a signature of Pete Dye's designs. The strategically placed bunkers and water hazards throughout the course provide an extraordinary test of golf. Unique to Pete Dye's creations, the surrounding native at Plum Creek adds color and texture that dramatically contrast with the manicured bent grass fairways and greens. The four sets of tees gives every golfer the chance to play from their ideal yardage while still enjoying all the course has to offer.

The Tournament Players Club (TPC) at Plum Creek was the home of the PGA Tour's second golf course development. TPC projects are part of the PGA Tour's overall plan for expanding world-class tournament golf and enhancing spectator enjoyment of tour events. One integral part of that plan was to build a signature stadium course, similar to the original at TPC Sawgrass in Florida. A stadium course is one that was constructed with the main goal being to provide great vantage points for fans and media. It incorporates mounding and hillsides around greens, in particular, where spectators can sit and enjoy the great golf being played.

The club opened in the spring of 1984 and was the home of the Senior PGA Tour's Denver Post Championship of Golf Event for the last four years of its six year existence (1984-1987). Players like Arnold Palmer, Lee Trevino, Chi Chi Rodriquez, Gary Player, Sam Snead, and many other current and future Golf Hall of Fame Members competed every year.

Tournament Package GOLF

TOURNAMENT COST

A tournament fee of \$16,000 includes a half day golf course buyout, as well as service and amenities in our tournament package. A \$2,500 deposit with a signed agreement will be required to secure a date. \$16,000 is all-inclusive of the following:

6 FULL-SERVICE ESSENTIALS

8_{AM} shotgun start. 144 max field. Full-service bag drop, tournament setup including registration area, pairings sheet, printed scorecards and name placards on golf carts. Our staff will place any applicable contest hole materials as well as sponsor signs on the golf course.

ON-SITE COORDINATOR

An experienced tournament coordinator will be on-site to assist with your event and an electronic scoreboard will be at the luncheon and awards ceremony.

6 WARM-UP

Practice balls and range are included for all participants.

O PRIZES

A prize fund of \$2,160 can be used in our golf shop towards merchandise and be divided up as you wish. As a *Colorado PGA Merchandiser of the Year* recipient, your guests will be thrilled with the selection and assortments in the golf shop.

6 LUNCH AND AWARDS

The awards luncheon will be hosted at The Oaks Clubhouse after golf. The Oaks is the original 40,000 square foot clubhouse that can accommodate large groups and is the perfect venue for your awards ceremony and post-golf luncheon. The Burger Buffet is included in the package and additional upgrades can be found in the lunch options menu.

Grilled flat iron steaks with a rosemary demi sauce along with beer can chicken, chef's choice of fresh vegetables, garden salad, jalapeño cheddar mashed potatoes and NY Style Cheesecake. (\$3,000 upgrade)

Drink tickets are valid for the golf course and Plum Creek clubhouse only. They are not valid at The Oaks clubhouse. All drink tickets are billed based on beverages redeemed. You can customize any items you'd like such as beer and soft drinks only or all beverage items on the beverage cart and snack bar when you set up your event. *Inquire for more details regarding your tournament*.
